Following the meetings of the Study Committees, the Board and the Ordinary General Assembly met in Cambridge last July.

Everybody thanked Dr. K.F. THOMPSON and the P.B.I. for organizing the meetings, for the quality of the material conditions and for the high interest of the technical visits to the P.B.I. and the N.I.A.B. (National Institute of Agricultural Botany).

During the meetings, major changes occurred in the G.C.I.R.C.: a new board and a new President were elected; P. VULLIOUD, from Switzerland, was appointed as new Vice Chairman of the Agronomy Committee, and 4 new members were agreed by the Board.

It was decided to create an International Award on Rapeseed Research. The winner will deliver an inaugural conference to the Conference.

The next G.C.I.R.C. annual meetings of the Board and to the General Assembly will stand in Poznan, Poland, in May, 1986.
