**INTERNATIONAL RAPESEED CONGRESS
to be held in Canada in 1991**

The Groupe Consultatif International de Recherche sur le Colza (GCIRC), with headquarters in Paris, arranges for International Congresses to be held every four years to provide a forum for presenting new scientific findings over a broad spectrum of rapeseed science and technology. Following on recent Congresses in Paris and Poznan, the Eighth Congress is to be held in Saskatoon, Canada in the centre of Canada's canola seed production. The dates are July 9 to 11, 1991.

The Congress will feature sessions on breeding, agronomy, physiology, chemistry, nutrition, economics and processing of rapeseed and canola. In addition a feature symposium of interest to all in attendance will follow immediately after the opening plenary session. Outstanding world authorities will address the broader issues and challenges facing the rapeseed industry.

Several workshops will be held immediately preceding the Congress dealing with breeding, agronomy and the disease blackspot, as well as analytical chemistry. Special tours are being arranged for after the Congress.
