Oilseed rape: nutrition for bees and source for residues

Oilseed rape is one of the most important nectar and pollen source for honey bees and few other pollinating insects. Due to the necessity for pesticide treatments against pests and disease during the flowering period, the contact of bees to the used ingredients seems to be unavoidable. The new application technology "Dropleg" is able to reduce the confrontation between bees with positive effects e.g. on honey quality.
