

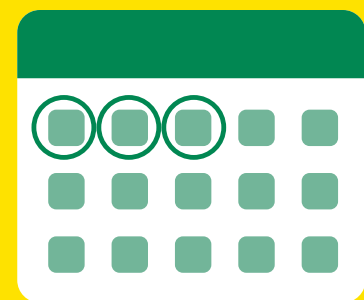

- 24 September 2023: IRC 2023 commences.

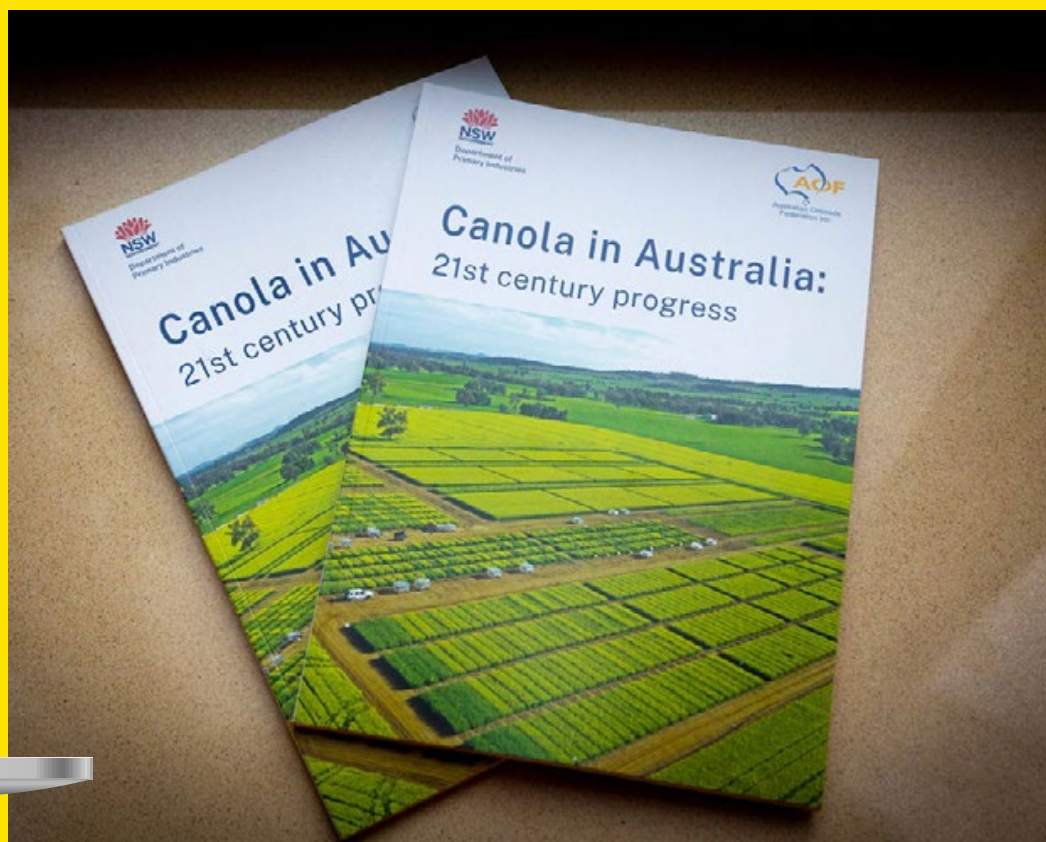
